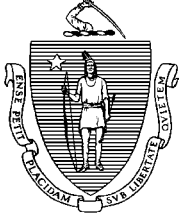

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND SEVEN

AN ACT RELATIVE TO NAMING A PORTION OF THE BREMEN STREET PARK IN EAST BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The 18-acre Bremen Street Park in the city of Boston, bordered on one side
- 2 by Route 1A/Interstate 90 and the opposite side by Bremen Street, shall have that portion
- 3 of the park at the playground located at the Bremen Street and Brooks Street entrance
- 4 designated and known as the Representative George DiLorenzo Playground, in honor of
- 5 George DiLorenzo who honorably served as a State Representative from East Boston
- 6 from 1965-70 and 1973-74. The Massachusetts Port Authority shall erect and maintain a

- 7 suitable marker on said portion of the park bearing this designation in compliance with
- 8 the standards of the Authority.
