## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND EIGHT

**AN ACT** AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MILTON TO ISSUE ONE ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES OF A CERTAIN RESTAURANT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding sections 11 and 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the licensing  
2 authority of the town of Milton may grant one additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages  
3 to be drunk on the premises to the restaurant located at 550 Adams street, which is owned by Vance  
4 Welch or his successor in interest; provided, however, that any successor in interest shall be subject to  
5 approval by the Milton board of selectmen and the alcoholic beverages control commission; provided  
6 further, that an application to transfer the license to a successor in interest shall be granted and  
7 approved according to the standard for a new license and section 15A of chapter 138 shall apply. The

8 license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138, except said section 17. The licensing authority of the  
9 town of Milton shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location.

10 (b) Notwithstanding any General or special law or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the licensing  
11 authority of the town of Milton shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location. The  
12 license may be re-issued by the licensing authority at the same location if an applicant for the license  
13 files with the licensing authority a letter in writing from the department of revenue indicating that the  
14 license is in good standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

15 (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall be  
16 returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the  
17 licensing authority of the town of Milton. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General  
18 Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, the licensing authority may then grant the  
19 license to a new applicant at the same location and under the same conditions as specified in  
20 subsection (b).

21 SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
