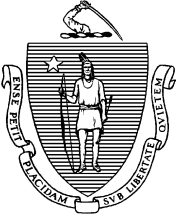

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND SEVEN

### **AN ACT** DESIGNATING CERTAIN BRIDGES IN THE TOWN OF MILLVILLE IN HONOR OF JOHN DEAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any rule or regulation of the department of highways to the  
2 contrary, the Bridges M-24-001, M-24-002, M-24-006, and M-24-007 spanning the Blackstone  
3 River in the Town of Millville shall be designated and known as the John Dean Bridge in Honor  
4 of Millville's Longtime Highway Surveyor and Dedicated Public Servant. The department of  
5 highways shall erect suitable markers bearing this designation in compliance with the standards  
6 of the department and any existing historic preservation guidelines or statutes.
