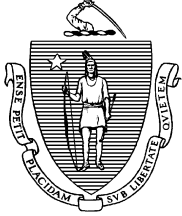

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND EIGHT

### **AN ACT** ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR MARK STANTON, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of public health, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 Executive Office of Health and Human Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Mark Stanton, an
- 3 employee within the Department of Public Health. Any employee of a department within the
- 4 Department of Public Health may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his sick, personal or vacation
- 5 days to the sick leave bank for use by Mark Stanton. Whenever Mark Stanton terminates employment

- 6 with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave time shall
- 7 be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
