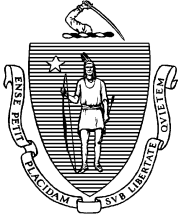

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND EIGHT

### **AN ACT** AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF JAMES A. MCNAMARA AS A POLICE OFFICER IN THE TOWN OF LANCASTER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or special
- 2 law, rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment,
- 3 James A. McNamara of the town of Leominster shall, if he meets all other requirements, be
- 4 eligible for employment on a permanent basis in the regular police force in the town of
- 5 Lancaster.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
