## AN ACT REGARDING THE COUNTABLE ASSETS OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 21A of Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out subsection

2   (2)(i) and replacing it with the following new subsection:

3           the type and amount of all countable assets; provided that any funds held by the community spouse of

4           an institutionalized applicant or recipient in an Individual Retirement Account, Keogh plan or other

5           pension fund shall be considered a non-countable asset as long as regular income distributions are

6           made from the fund or the community spouse is employed;
