AN ACT RELATING TO THE POLICE CAREER INCENTIVE PAY PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 108L of chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2     inserting after the words “The board of higher education is hereby authorized and directed to  
3     establish and maintain a list of approved courses leading to a degree in law enforcement” the  
4     following:-

5     “Any full-time member of a police department participating taking approved coursework at an  
6     accredited college or university shall not be responsible for fees from the college or university  
7     associated with enrollment in the approved course or courses.”
