AN ACT CONTINUING RETIREMENT GROUP MEMBERSHIP FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4(1) of chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2004
2 Official Edition is amended by adding a new section (t) at the end of said section 1 as follows:
- 3 Any member may, if currently or previously a member in Group IV, continue in or be returned to
4 Group IV upon appointment to the following positions: Secretary and any Under Secretary or
5 Assistant Secretary of Public Safety; Municipal Police Commissioner; Executive Director, staff
6 member, Instructor and Academy Directors of the Municipal Police Training Committee; and
7 investigators in the various District Attorneys offices.
