### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “section”, in line 307, the  
3   following words:- ; uniformed employees of a municipal or public emergency medical service  
4   who are certified at any level as emergency medical technicians by the department of public  
5   health, if they are members of the state retirement system, or, upon acceptance of this  
6   classification in the same manner as in subsection (a) of section 103, if they are members of any  
7   system other than the state employees' retirement system and the teachers' retirement system.
