AN ACT ERECTING A CLARA BARTON SIGN ON I-395.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any policy or regulation of the Massachusetts Highway  
2 Department to the contrary, the department is hereby authorized and directed to erect and  
3 maintain two signs on Route I-395 at exit 5 northbound and southbound in the town of Oxford  
4 marking and directing motorists to the birthplace of Clara Barton, founder of the American Red  
5 Cross, teacher, national heroine, and native of Oxford, Massachusetts.
