AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' SERVICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2 edition is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph one, the following: -
- 3 “Provided further, the secretary shall be a veteran, as defined in clause Forty-third of section 7 of  
4 chapter 4 of the Massachusetts General Laws.”
