AN ACT RELATIVE TO A SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT STATEMENT.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide for an impact statement, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 30A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
3 paragraph:-

4 A small business impact statement shall be filed with the state secretary on the same day
5 the notice is filed and shall accompany the notice. Notwithstanding section 6, the state secretary
6 shall include the small business impact statement on the electronic website of the state secretary,

7 and the statement may be inspected and copied in the office of the state secretary during business
8 hours.
