Grant funding obligation action for referenced grant project per NEG Agreement. See Grantee application dated June 18, 2013, which is incorporated by reference.

Additional Special Terms and Conditions: The Grantee must submit a grant modification request within 60 days to address the following:

Grant Period - The approved Grant Period is July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015, consistent with the Program Year 2013 funding source.

Funding Amount - The approved threshold amount is up to \$1,081,678 for the overall Grant Period, with an initial obligation/award of \$560,754. Additional increments may be provided based upon enrollments and expenditures and will be subject to the availability of Federal funds. The Grantee must submit a grant modification to revise the budget and plan documents to reflect the initial award amount within the Grant Period limitations. In the interim, the budget and plan figures are approved as reflected on Quarter 5 of the Planning Form, subject to the following stipulations and/or issues that must also be addressed:

Administrative Costs (Project Operator Level) - The Grantee must provide a breakout of the costs associated with each of the subcomponents that comprise the \$103,017.

Narrative Statements/Employer Data Forms - The Grantee must revise the Narrative Statements and/or the Employer Data Forms as it is unclear why only one layoff date is shown on these forms. Specifically, in response to "This event date is more than 120 days prior to the submission date.

Please explain why affected workers are still in need of and seeking assistance," the Narrative Statements indicate "...due to staggered layoffs." Also in response to "Please explain why the number of planned participants for this employer is less than 50," the Narrative Statements indicate "The company continues to lay off workers in smaller groups."

SF-424, Item 8a - The Grantee must confirm/correct its legal name, shown on the SF-424 as the Massachusetts Department of Workforce Development; whereas the legal name currently shown at www.sam.gov for the Dun and Bradstreet Numbering System (DUNS), is the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development.

SF-424, Item 16a - The Grantee must revise the entry in Item 16a to reflect Congressional District 8 (Applicant Only), as a result of the redistricting for the 113th Congress.

Employer Data Forms - The Grantee must revise the Employer Data Forms (A.L. Ellis, Reflek Corporation, and Victor Innovative Textiles), as some list a Date of Notification that is subsequent to the Layoff Date.

Project Operator Data Form (PODF) - The Grantee must revise the information on this form, as appropriate. Specifically, the Project Operator name is shown as the Bristol County Training Consortium, but the address is that of the Bristol Workforce Investment Board; and it appears as if the contact name and phone/fax numbers are associated with the Fall River Career Center.
