Subject: **Reemployment Eligibility Assessment (REA) and Related MOSES Training**

Purpose: To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce investment partners of REA program training scheduled for June and July, 2010.

Background: DUA, the DCS Central Programs Unit, and the MOSES training staff will conduct three training sessions in June and July (see Chart, below) covering all REA/RES program requirements. Training sessions are a half-day in length and are currently scheduled in Worcester, Boston and Lawrence. If needed, additional training sessions will be scheduled at a future date.

The training content will cover RES program basics, the REA program overview and requirements, the Career MAP, the Eligibility Status Review, changes to MOSES data entry related to RES/REA, and interagency coordination with the Career Centers.
