Subject: **Career Center Performance Report (CCPR) Tab on Massworkforce.org**

Purpose: To notify local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce investment partners of the availability of a Career Center Performance Reports (CCPR) tab on Massworkforce.org.

Background: The Career Center Performance Reports (CCPR) are published quarterly by the Department of Career Services. They are released through a MassWorkforce Issuance that is posted on the massworkforce.org website, and printed in book form and mailed directly to Career Centers and workforce partners. WIA Title I Annual Performance Results are released through a separate MassWorkforce Issuance and comprise an update to Tab 11 (Adults, Dislocated Workers and Youth) of each fiscal year's 4th Quarter CCPR.

Beginning with Fiscal Year 2011, DCS introduced an Annual CCPR containing all final fiscal year performance report data. The Annual CCPR is released through a MassWorkforce Issuance and in printed book form. The first annual CCPR for FY 2011 was released through MassWorkforce Issuance 11-68, *Career Center Performance Reports - Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2011*, on November 10, 2011.

The new tab on the massworkforce.org website – CCPR – provides easy access to all MassWorkforce Issuances of the Career Center Performance Reports and WIA Title I Annual Performance Results by collecting them on a Career Center Performance Reports page accessible from the main menu bar.

This tab formerly was assigned to ARRA. The ARRA information is now available on the Resources tab.
