Subject: **FY2012 WIA Title I Annual Performance Results**

Purpose: To distribute to local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce investment partners the Massachusetts FY2012 WIA Title I Annual Performance results.

Background: The Workforce Investment Act specifies core performance measures for Title I programs for adult, dislocated worker and youth services. Beginning with FY2012, the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, approved a waiver for Massachusetts to report under the Common Measures. The Common Measures goals approved by DOLETA were issued in MassWorkforce Issuance #11-56 on September 12, 2011.

Annual Performance for Massachusetts and Workforce Areas

Attachment A provides a copy of the Program Year 2011 (FY2012) Annual Report on Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth Activities that was filed with the U.S. Department of Labor on October 1, 2011. The report presents information on state and local performance relative to the nine Common Measures, and information on program costs, research and evaluation, use of waivers, and business engagement strategies.

Annual Career Center Performance Reports

Career Center Performance Reports, Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2012 will be published in November. The annual report will be inclusive of all final program service data and final performance data for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012. The Annual CCPR will update fourth quarter CCPR data (MassWorkforce Issuance 12-45, issued August 22, 2012) and incorporate additional performance related data that was entered in MOSES after June 30, 2012. The Annual CCPR combines all fiscal year program and performance data in one publication.
