

Services for Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers

While, One-Stop Career Centers (OSCCs) design services to meet local needs, there are core services provided to Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers (MSFWs) that are similar across the statewide network of OSCCs, these include:

- ✓ Information on types of jobs available
- ✓ Referrals to supportive services
- ✓ Assistance with completion of registration
- ✓ Job development
- ✓ Job referrals
- ✓ Testing
- ✓ Complaint resolution
- ✓ Counseling
- ✓ Training opportunities (if eligible)
- ✓ Information about farmworkers rights that are protected by state and federal laws
- ✓ Information about other organizations serving MSFWs

Most farmworkers in Massachusetts work in labor intensive crop activities such as fruits, vegetables, tobacco, greenhouse and nursery. In general, agricultural workers include field crop, equipment operators and livestock workers.

In some Career Centers, services are available in languages other than English. Depending on location, these languages may include Spanish, Chinese, Portuguese, Russian and Vietnamese
