Request for public assistance In Norwood homicide

Authorities today (March 14, 2016) identify the victim in last night's shooting homicide in Norwood as Edison Tejada, a resident of the Stone Bridge Apartments where it took place. District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey and Police Chief William G. Brooks, III now request assistance from the public.

"Those who knew Edison Tejada and may have known his movements in the period before his murder can help us piece together what has happened here," District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey said Monday afternoon. "Detectives are actively interviewing those of his family and friends whom we have identified, but anyone who may have information about this crime or about Edison's activities before the murder are asked to contact police at 781-440-5181."

Norwood Police were called to the Dean Street apartment complex at 1:39 a.m. by a neighbor. Edison Tejada was alive when Norwood police reached him and transported to the Norwood Hospital, less than a mile away. He did not survive his injuries.

Tejada had a previous address on North Main Street in Brockton.
