REPORTED REASONS FOR DELIQUENCIES

REGIONAL FORECLOSURE PREVENTION AND EDUCATION

CENTERS:

- LOSS OF INCOME: 88%
- DIVORCE OR SEPARATION: 6%
- INCREASE IN LOAN PAYMENT: 3%

LOCAL CONSUMER AGENCIES:

- LOSS OF INCOME: 69%
- POOR BUDGET MANAGEMENT: 11%
- DIVORCE OR SEPARATION: 8%

PROGRAM OUTCOMES:

- 40% OF CLIENTS ARE IN ACTIVE COUNSELING
- 29% ACTIVE WAITING FOR LOAN MODIFICATIONS
