I own some properties in Eastham, MA and I am outraged at the rates I pay for homeowners insurance. I pay a higher rate, because I rent the properties which is understandable. However, the policies are essentially fire insurance for considerably more than I pay at my home in PA, for property of considerably more value.

Recently, I inquired about the my rate increase and was told that rates increase an automatic 4%, for starters, to cover inflation. When in the past 20 years has inflation been 4% ?

Two years ago I compared costs and coverage from each of the three insurance companies that insure Cape Cod properties. The coverage and costs were identical. Smacks at Taft - Hartley.

Please consider putting a leash on these insurers. The cost for such limited coverage is excessive and seemingly uncontrolled.
