## **Massachusetts Announcement**

**Effective April 15th, 2013**

The Division of Insurance (“Division”) is pleased to announce that beginning on April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013, individual applicants (**both resident and non-resident**) applying for new Producer licenses in Massachusetts may now do so online via the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR). The Division will be enhancing its own online licensing system (OLLIE) later in 2013 to provide similar new online licensing. OLLIE remains available for updating of Producer licenses and renewing of Producer licenses.

The Division has now partnered with NIPR for the following online procedures:

- New Individual Producers
- Renewing Individual Producers
- Renewing Business Entity Producers
- New & renewing Individual Surplus Lines Brokers (only thru NIPR, no paper apps.)
- New & renewing Business Entity Surplus Lines Brokers (only thru NIPR, no paper apps.)
- ACR
- PDB
- Document Warehouse

The Division’s next project with NIPR, beginning in the near future, will be for the licensing of new business entity producers; please watch for announcements in the summer.
