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**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, §§ 61, 90, 94A, and 96, and M.G.L. c. 30A, § 2, the Board of Registration of Chiropractors will hold a public hearing relative to the proposed promulgation of amendments to its regulations, 233 CMR §§ 2.00 through 5.00, which govern the practice of chiropractic in the Commonwealth. By these proposed amendments, the Board seeks to establish minimum qualifications and standards of practice for chiropractors performing peer review, update the scope of practice regulation, and delete outdated references in the existing regulation. The proposed changes also seek to reduce administrative burdens on licensed chiropractors by eliminating the need for the Board to preapprove continuing education courses, clarifying record keeping and chiropractic facility requirements, and limiting the fees charged for reinstating a lapsed license.

The hearing will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 8, 2016, at the Division of Professional Licensure in a first floor conference room at 1000 Washington Street, Boston, MA 02118. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony, orally or in writing, at the hearing. The Board will also accept written comments regarding the proposed amendments through the end of business on September 15, 2016.
