The Board of State Examiners of Electricians is considering changes to 237 CMR 12.00 to 23.00, the Rules and Regulations governing the registration and conduct of Massachusetts electricians and systems installers. More specifically, the Board is considering updating these regulations to reflect changes in the industry since the last major regulation update in 2007. Some of the topics to be considered for amendment include education requirements and curriculums, expiration rules governing old education and work experience, acceptance of educational training for credit towards work experience requirements, and business license requirements.
