NOTICE OF MEETINGS

The Board of Registration of Electrologists (“the Board”) has appointed a subcommittee to propose revisions to regulations governing electrologists at 238 CMR 2.00 and 238 CMR 3.00.¹ To facilitate the development of these regulations, the Board invites all interested parties to attend one of two public meetings.

The meetings are intended to serve as listening sessions, in which interested parties and stakeholders may provide information that will be helpful to the Board and the subcommittee in proposing regulations on the electrology profession.

At these meetings, the Board is seeking general input from interested parties and stakeholders on topics including:

- Definitions
- Equipment Requirements
- Electrology Education and Schools
