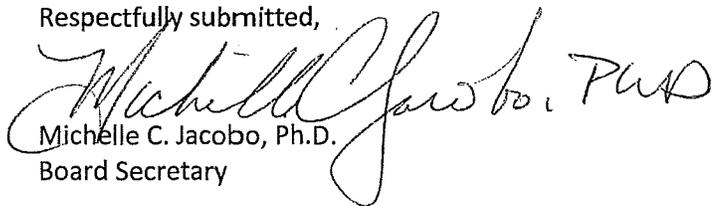
### Board Business:

1. At 9:05 am, meeting called to order. At 9:07 am, on a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Dr. Carey, all in favor, the Board voted to enter investigative session for PY-15-007, PY-15-004, PY-15-010.
2. At 9:21 am, on a motion by Dr. Carey seconded by Dr. Bistis, the Board voted to exit investigative session and enter open session, all in favor.
3. Dr. Sanchez explained the evacuation instructions in case of emergency.
4. On a motion by Dr. Jacobo, seconded by Dr. Bistis, the Board voted to approve the public meeting minutes as amended and the executive session minutes for December 2014, all in favor.
5. Discussion about proposed regulation changes was tabled. This discussion will be on February agenda.
6. Discussion about Board Member terms and areas of expertise for potential future board members.
7. PY-15-007: On a motion by Dr. Jacobo, seconded by Dr. Bistis, the Board voted to dismiss, all in favor.
8. PY-15-004: On a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Ms. Jain, the Board voted to dismiss, all in favor except Dr. Carey who abstained.
9. PY-15-010: On a motion by Dr. Jacobo, seconded by Dr. Scherer, the Board voted to dismiss, all in favor.
10. Licensee #6329: The Board reviewed quarterly report.
11. Lofgren-CE audit: Board reviewed. On a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Dr. Hudgins, the Board voted to accept her CEs, all in favor.
12. Pre-applicant Yeon Soo, Oh: Board reviewed correspondence and international credentials evaluation from ECE. The Board determined that this individual has the equivalent of a doctoral degree in psychology, but is missing almost all the required courses for licensure. In addition, the Board does not accept supervised experience completed outside the USA. The Board will send a letter explaining this and suggesting that re-specialization may be the best option. The letter will also indicate that this individual cannot practice psychology or call him or herself a Psychologist. On a motion by Dr. Jacobo, and seconded by Dr. Bistis this motion carries, all in favor.
13. Correspondence from Dr. Dorn from MSPP: The Board reviewed and discussed letter. On a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Dr. Scherer, the Board voted that for students that were in program prior to July 1, 2013, those 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year internships will be regarded as internship experiences in terms of

regulatory requirements. For students who entered the program on or after July 1, 2013, those hours will need to meet advanced practicum requirements, all in favor.

14. Applicant Benson: On a motion by Dr. Hudgins, seconded by Dr. Scherer, the Board voted that the hours meet direct client contact requirement, however more information will be requested about professional activities since 2010, all in favor.
15. At 10:45 am, on a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Dr. Bistis, the Board voted to enter Investigative Session to further discuss information contained in PY-15-004, all in favor.
16. At 10:50 am, on a motion by Ms. Jain, seconded by Dr. Scherer, the Board voted to enter Open Session.
17. At 10:55 am, on a roll call vote, the Board voted to exit open session and enter executive session pursuant to General Laws Chapter 30A Section 21 (a)(7) to discuss medical record information and to comply with the public record law, pursuant to G.L. c. 66, § 10; G.L. c. 4, § 7, ¶ 26(c), all in favor.
18. At 11:15 am, on a roll call vote, the Board voted to exit open session and enter executive session pursuant to General Laws Chapter 30A, Section 21(a)(7) to comply with the confidentiality provisions of the Mass. CORI statute, G. L. c. 66, § 10; G. L. c. 4 § 7, ¶ 26(a), G. L. c. 6, § 172)
19. At 11:32 am, on a roll call vote, the Board voted to exit executive session and return to open meeting, all in favor.
