1. At 9:06 a.m., the meeting was called to order.
2. At 9:07 a.m., on a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Dr. Hudgins, all in favor, the Board voted to enter into closed session for the purposes of investigative conferences for: PY-16-007, PY-15-058, PY-16-001389, PY-16-004, PY-16-012, and PY-16-001.
3. At 11:50 a.m., on a motion by Ms. Allen, seconded by Dr. Glover, all in favor, the Board voted to exit closed session and to enter open session.
4. Dr. Jacobo reviewed evacuation instructions.
5. On a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Ms. Allen, the Board voted to approve, as amended, the Board Meeting and Executive Session minutes for the December 2015 meeting, all in favor.
6. PY-16-007: On a motion by Dr. Hudgins, seconded by Dr. Sanchez, the Board voted to schedule an investigative conference with the licensee in February, all in favor.

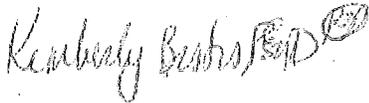

At 12:02 p.m., Dr. Sanchez moved to exit open session and enter Executive Session, pursuant to General Laws Chapter 30A, Section 21(a)(7) to discuss medical record information and to comply with the public record law, pursuant to G. 15. Pre-Applicant Hale: On a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Dr. Carey, the Board voted to request additional information regarding her health service work, all in favor.
16. At 12:30 p.m., on a motion by Dr. Bistis, seconded by Dr. Glover, the Board voted to adjourn for lunch, all in favor.
17. At 1:06 p.m., the Board the Board resumed open session.
18. At 1:07 p.m., on a motion by Dr. Sanchez, seconded by Ms. Allen, the Board voted to exit open session and enter closed session for the purposes for Settlement Conference for PY-14-022, all in favor.
19. At 1:25 p.m., on a motion by Dr. Hudgins, seconded by Dr. Sanchez, the Board voted to exit closed session and resume open session, all in favor.
20. Applicant Phillips-Stoll: The Board reviewed and discussed application with applicant present. On a motion by Dr. Sanchez, seconded by Dr. Carey, the Board voted to accept her two post-doctoral placements at HVMA as a continuous experience, all in favor.
21. Applicant Gorman: The Board reviewed application. On a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Dr. Hudgins, the Board voted to approve health service training program hours, all in favor. Dr. Sanchez took no part in the discussion or deliberation of this matter.
22. Pre-applicant Woldorf: The Board reviewed correspondence. On a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Dr. Sanchez, the Board voted to request that the pre-applicant present a plan for internship and report back to the board, all in favor.
23. Applicant Lee: The Board reviewed application. On a motion by Dr. Carey, seconded by Dr. Glover, the Board voted to deny the application, all in favor except for Dr. Sanchez who was recused.
24. Board Counsel Report: Provided by Attorney Kelley. Board voted to accept counsel recommendation to grant conditional licensure for applicant Green, with the conditional licensure agreement in place for 5 years, with 1 hour of supervision per month, and revocation

of license if any complaints are filed against the future licensee. So moved by Dr. Carey and seconded by Dr. Glover, all in favor, other than Dr. Sanchez who abstained.
