- Pursuant to M.G.L. C. 112, S. 1A, when renewing a license, the licensee must acknowledge his or her obligations as they pertain to the reporting of suspected child abuse or neglect under M.G.L. C. 119, S. 51A and the punishment for failure to comply, which includes criminal fines and / or imprisonment. Such obligations also include the completion of training to recognize and report suspected child abuse or neglect.
- Pursuant to M.G.L. C. 19C, S. 1-13, licensees are required to report abuse/neglect of disabled persons to the disabled persons protection commission.
- **CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK:**
The Board is certified by the Department of Criminal Justice Information Services to access data about convictions and pending criminal cases.

Those and other Federal and professional records may be checked as part of your licensing renewal. No records are automatic disqualifiers as you will be given an opportunity to discuss any issues with the Board.
