

6. The outcome of this proceeding will directly affect SELCO's competitive position. If the DTC grants Verizon's request and eliminates the reporting of subscriber information on Form 500, such information still could be subject to disclosure by SELCO and other municipal cable operators under the public records law. As such, granting Verizon's petition would place SELCO at a competitive disadvantage.
7. SELCO submits that the DTC has a legitimate interest in receiving subscriber information from all cable operators and SELCO's participation in this proceeding will assist the DTC in its investigation.
8. Accordingly, SELCO seeks limited participant status in this proceeding, and where appropriate, to file comments, attend and participate in technical conferences, submit briefs and to participate in this proceeding in any other manner deemed appropriate for limited participants by the Hearing Officer.

Wherefore, based on the foregoing, SELCO respectfully requests that its petition for limited participant status be granted.
