### CASE STATUS CONFERENCE NOTICE

On February 3, 2016, representatives for Prisoners Legal Services (“PLS”), Securus Technologies, Inc. (“Securus”), Inmate Calling Solutions d/b/a ICSolutions (“ICSolutions”), and Global Tel\*Link (“GTL”) (collectively “Parties”) submitted Joint Response to Official Notice of January 22, 2016 (“Response”) to the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”). The Parties proposed three possible dates for a telephonic case status conference, February 23, February 29, or March 1, 2016. The Parties also agree that a hearing on pending motions to compel discovery should be postponed until issues raised in the status conference are resolved. The parties also informed the Department that GTL and Securus have filed motions for a partial stay of the FCC’s Order pending judicial review and that Securus has requested that the Court resolve the stay request by February 26, 2016, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

After considering the proposed dates and the Parties’ additional information concerning the pending motions for a partial stay of the FCC’s Order, the Department has selected February 29, 2016 as the date for the telephonic case status conference. Accordingly, the Department will hold a telephonic case status conference on Monday, February 29, 2016 at 2:00 PM (EST) to

discuss the effect the FCC's Order has on the scope of its proceeding, as detailed in the Department's January 22, 2016 Notice. The Department will email the Parties the dial-in information for the call bridge once those details have been confirmed.
