ORDER ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On June 4, 2014, Global Tel*Link Corporation (“GTL”) filed its Motion for Extension of Time (“Motion”) requesting that GTL, the Petitioners, and Securus Technologies, Inc. (“Securus”) each be given an extension of time to respond to relevant motions to compel filed on May 30, 2014. In its Motion, GTL states that it has the agreement of the Petitioners and Securus to request an extension of time, from June 6, 2014 to June 25, 2014, for GTL, Petitioners, and Securus to file their responses.

As GTL's Motion is agreed to by the Petitioners and Securus, and good cause has been shown, the Department hereby GRANTS GTL's Motion for Extension of Time and resets the deadline for responses to motions to compel to June 25, 2014.
