**Re: DTC 14-6, *Petition of Charter Communications to establish and adjust the basic service tier programming, equipment, and installation rates in Massachusetts served by Charter Communications that are currently subject to rate regulation***

Dear Ms. Clark:

On behalf of Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter"), this letter confirms Charter's request that the Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Cable ("Department") further extend certain deadlines arising from the Rate Order issued by the Department on October 30, 2015, in the above-referenced docket.

Specifically, in a telephone conversation I had with Hearing Officer Sean Carroll on Thursday, May 26, 2016, Charter requested that the Department extend further until July 1, 2016, the deadlines for: (1) Charter to file the refund plan as directed on page 16 of the Rate Order; (2) Charter to file a motion for reconsideration or notice an appeal of the Rate Order to the FCC. Charter will notify the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") of this extension to ensure its right to appeal the Rate Order to that agency is preserved. Charter will copy Mr. Carroll on any correspondence with the FCC regarding this matter.
