
Dear Ms. Clark,

On behalf of Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”), this letter confirms the agreement by Charter and the Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) to further extend certain deadlines arising from the Rate Order issued by the Department on October 30, 2015, in the above-referenced docket.

Specifically, in an email exchange I had with Hearing Officer Sean Carroll on Wednesday, September 28, 2016, we agreed that the Department would extend further until October 31, 2016, the deadlines for: (1) Charter to file the refund plan as directed on page 16 of the Rate Order; and (2) Charter to file a motion for reconsideration or notice of appeal of the Rate order to the FCC. Charter has notified the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) of this extension to ensure its right to appeal the Rate Order to that agency is preserved, and it copied appropriate Department Staff on its correspondence with the FCC.
