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**FIRST SET OF INFORMATION REQUESTS  
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND CABLE  
TO TIME WARNER CABLE**

Pursuant to 801 C.M.R. § 1.01(8)(g), the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) submits to Time Warner Cable the following information requests:

Instructions

1. Each request should be answered in writing on a separate page with a recitation of the request, a reference to the request number, the docket number of the case, and the name of the person responsible for the answer.
2. These requests shall be deemed continuing so as to require further supplemental responses if Time Warner Cable or its witness(es) receives or generates additional information within the scope of these requests between the time of the original response and the close of the record in this proceeding.
3. The terms “provide detailed calculations” and “provide detailed documentation” mean:  
  
Provide all data, assumptions, and calculations relied upon. Provide the source of and basis for all data and assumptions employed. Include all studies, reports, and planning documents from which data, estimates, or assumptions were drawn and support for how the data or assumptions were used in developing the projections or estimates. Provide and explain all supporting workpapers.
4. If any one of these requests is ambiguous, notify the Department so that the request may be clarified prior to the preparation of a written response.
5. File an original and three copies of the responses with Sara Clark, Secretary of the Department, not later than **July 31, 2015**.

## Requests

- D.T.C. 1-1 Please confirm that the Projected Period for Time Warner Cable's Form 1240s ends on February 28, 2016, and not February 29, 2016.
- D.T.C. 1-2 Please provide detailed documentation explaining the decrease in the total Capital Cost of Service Installation and Maintenance of Equipment and Plant (Schedule A, Line L) from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.
- D.T.C. 1-3 Please provide detailed documentation explaining the decrease in the total Annual Operating Expenses for Service Installation and Maintenance of Equipment (Schedule B, Line B) from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.
- D.T.C. 1-4 Please provide detailed documentation explaining the decrease in the total Number of Units in Service for Converter 3, and Other Equipment (Schedule C, Line C) from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.
- D.T.C. 1-5 Please provide detailed documentation explaining the decrease in the total Capital Cost of Leased Customer Equipment (Schedule C, Line L) from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.
- D.T.C. 1-6 Please justify Time Warner Cable's proposed Hourly Service Charge of \$119.63 (Step A, Line 7) on this year's Form 1205, including detailed documentation explaining the increase of the surcharge from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.<sup>1</sup>
- D.T.C. 1-7 Please provide detailed documentation reconciling the 28% decrease in the Total Cost of Converter 2 (Step D, Line 22, Column b) with the 42% decrease in the Number of Converter 2 Units in Service (Schedule C, Line C) from the previous year's Form 1205 to this year's Form 1205.

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<sup>1</sup> In D.T.C. Docket 13-10, the Department prescribed an hourly service charge of \$60.32 for Time Warner Cable's previous year's Form 1205. *In re Petition of Time Warner Cable for Review of FCC Forms 1240 and Form 1205 for the Great Barrington, N. Adams, & Pittsfield Sys., D.T.C. 13-10, Rate Order* (Nov. 26, 2014) ("Rate Order"). Time Warner Cable appealed the Rate Order to the FCC and also requested that the FCC stay the Rate Order. Both pleadings are still pending at the FCC. Accordingly, the Rate Order remains in effect.
