
Dear Ms. Clark:

This letter confirms that per my phone conversation and e-mail exchange with Hearing Officer Sean Carroll last week, Time Warner Cable Inc. (“TWC”) and the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) have agreed to further extend until Thursday, March 17, 2016, all deadlines arising from the Rate Order in the above-referenced docket.

Specifically, it is TWC understands that the Department has agreed to further extend the deadlines for: (1) TWC to file the refund plan as directed on page 19 of the Rate Order; and (2) TWC to file a motion for reconsideration or notice an appeal of the Rate Order to the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”). TWC intends to notify the FCC of this extension to ensure its right to appeal the Rate Order to that agency is preserved. TWC or its counsel will copy Hearing Officer Carroll on any correspondence related to this notification.
