

TIME WARNER CABLE'S RESPONSE TO RECORD REQUESTS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND CABLE MADE AT PUBLIC AND EVIDENTIARY HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 24, 2015.

Request #2:

How many units of each particular piece of customer premises equipment were retired and how many were not written off and how many were added during Fiscal Year 2014?

Response #2:

In Fiscal Year 2014 (10/2013 to 9/2014) Time Warner Cable added 135,544 and retired 181,303 Converter 2 (addressable) units; added 47,616 and retired 4,131 Converter 3 (DTA) units; and added 2,240 and retired 228 other equipment (cable card) units. All retirements were written off. The above numbers are adjusted to account for the number of regulated subscribers.
