Notice of the State 911 Department to Adjust the Enhanced 911 Surcharge

On March 20, 2015, the State 911 Department petitioned the Department of Telecommunications and Cable ("Department") to adjust the Enhanced 911 surcharge for each subscriber or end user whose communication is received by the Department's Dispatching and utilizing the enhanced 911 services as of June 30, 2015. The Department proposed to adjust the surcharge to \$1.00 per month from a reduction to \$1.00, effective July 1 through June 30, 2016. The Department also proposed to increase the surcharge to \$1.00 per month from a reduction to \$1.00, effective July 1 through June 30, 2016. Pursuant to G.L.c. 64A, § 18H(d).

This proceeding is docketed as D.T.C. 15-2 and the Department will assign the State 911 Department request as a formal adjudicative proceeding conducted under G.L.c. 30A, § 20A. The Department's Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure apply to this proceeding.


