MBI will also hold a public meeting in western Massachusetts to provide municipal officials and residents of Hardwick and Montague with an opportunity to share perspectives directly with MBI and Commissioner of the Commonwealth's Department of Telecommunications and Cable (DTC), Karen Charles Peterson. This meeting time and location will be posted when it is confirmed.

Commissioner Charles Peterson will review the comments and other documentation related to the Comcast and Matrix proposals and will submit a grant funding recommendation to the MBI Board of Directors and Executive Committee of the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MassTech) Board of Directors. This process will conclude with a decision by the MBI Board and MassTech Executive Committee in June.
