Ethics Commission Fines Ex Middlesex Board Member Lawrence Driscoll

Fined \$10,000, Civil Forfeiture \$2,683

Today the Supreme Judicial Court issued its decision in the case dealing with the status of personal use of employer-owned motor vehicles as regular compensation. (Pelonzi & another v. Retirement Board of Beverly & another, SJC 10098), The Court vacated Essex Superior Court Judge Patrick J. Riley's opinion and directed that a new judgment be entered declaring that the value of personal use of Mr. Pelonzi's automobile is not includable as part of his "regular compensation" under G.L. c. 32, s. 1.
