## MEMORANDUM

DATE: December 4, 2009

Required Fiscal Year 2011 Appropriation: **\$48,986,967**

This Commission is hereby furnishing you with the amount to be appropriated for your retirement system for Fiscal Year 2011 which commences July 1, 2010.

Attached please find the portion of the Fiscal Year 2011 appropriation to be paid by each of the governmental units within your system. The amounts were determined by Buck. The Board has not formally adopted a schedule based on the January 1, 2008 actuarial valuation, so we have not provided the five-year projection of scheduled appropriations. However, they have agreed to appropriate \$48,986,967 for FY11. Our letter is based on this amount.

This appropriation letter reflects the allocation as in past years with the sheriff's office included. After the unfunded liability of the retired sheriff's office employees that remain in each system as of December 31, 2009 is determined and provided to PERAC, the County units' appropriations will be revised. The FY11 appropriation for all other governmental units in your Systems will not be adjusted.

If your System has a valuation currently in progress, you may submit a revised funding schedule to PERAC upon its completion. The current schedule is/was due to be updated by Fiscal Year 2011.
