MREP RiderCoach rules of Professional Conduct

The MREP rules of Professional Conduct are designed to ensure that RiderCoaches conduct course activities in a SAFE, EFFICIENT and PROFESSIONAL manner.

As a MSF certified, MREP approved RiderCoach, I agree to:

1. Maintain my Motorcycle Safety Foundation certification(s) for all course I conduct
2. Consistently promote the safest learning environment possible
3. Demonstrate safe riding habits including wearing proper riding gear when riding to, from, and during all rider training activities.
4. Assure that MREP and site owned equipment entrusted to me is properly used and securely stored.
5. Maintain a valid license to operate a motorcycle and maintain a good driving record.
6. Operate a motorcycle on a routine basis.
7. Inform MREP administration of any changes in personal data in a timely fashion.
8. Obtain MREP approval prior to taking a position as a RiderCoach on legislative or advocacy issues in a public forum pertaining to motorcycling
9. Use current curriculum and administrative materials as appropriate and maintain awareness of MREP policies and its revisions.
