## Critical definitions

Please note: the following terms and definition apply to COVID-19 only. Updated 4/5/2023
Doses administered: All doses of COVID-19 vaccine vaccine that have been reported to MIIS are included in this measurement. This includes doses reported by RICAIR, the Rhode Island immunization registry, and the Veterans Administration for individuals with Massachusetts addresses.
At least one dose: An individual is counted as having at least one dose if they have a COVID-19 vaccine on record.
Primary series complete: An individual is counted as having primary series complete if they meet the CDC guidelines (see
https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/stay-up-to-date.html), which are based on age and vaccine formulation.
Boosted after 9/1/2022: An individual is counted as boosted if they received a booster dose of vaccine after $9 / 1 / 2022$. (For a small number of children, this included monovalent boosters for a series of weeks.) Updated guidance replaces previous guidance for individuals to receive multiple boosters based on age or medical condition.

No doses: This is an estimate based on subtracting the number of people who received at least one dose from the population estimate the specified population. It is possible for individuals to have received vaccine without it being reported to MIIS.

MIIS: Immunization data from most (but not all) providers in Massachusetts are reported into the Massachusetts Immunization Information System (MIIS) through direct messages from electronic health records or direct entry by users. Due to inputting and processing, it may take 24-48 hours or more for administration data to appear in MIIS. MIIS data are available for analysis one calendar day after they are reported to the MIIS. Data are current as of time of publication and may be subject to change in future publications as additional data are reported.
