The H4672 Act Addressing COVID-19 Data Collection and Disparities in Treatment

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**Population:** The population covered in this report includes all inmates incarcerated in a Massachusetts DOC facility who occupy a bed on the date of the report. The count will exclude inmates who are transferred outside of the DOC for a long term period of time, inmates who are transferred to a Remand and inmates who are released to an outside hospital. For report purposes, these inmates are reported as OUT-OF-DOC Transfers.<sup>1</sup>

### **Report Requirements**

The Department of Correction shall report the total number of residents per correctional facility; and the number of residents within each facility who are housed in a cell: (i) alone; (ii) with one (1) other person; or (iii) with two (2) or more other people; provided, however, that the Department of Correction and each sheriff provide this residential housing count information not less than weekly to the Department of Public Health.

Table 1 below displays the number of inmates incarcerated in the Massachusetts Department of Correction housed in a cell: (i) alone; (ii) with one (1) other person; or (iii) with two (2) or more other people. The table provides counts and a percentage break down. The inmates who are not currently active in a cell are termed as OUT-OF-DOC Transfer and the table provides a separate count of these inmates. Please note that percentages may not always add up to 100% due to rounding.

- Remand to FED/HOC/OUT OF STATE: Transfers inmates to another state and/or authority as a result of legal action by that other authority (E.g. prosecution, I.A.D.)
- Release to Outside Hospital: Transfers an inmate to an OUTSIDE hospital (a non-DOC infirmary). The Lemuel Shattuck Hospital Outpatient Department and Lemuel Shattuck ICU (Intensive Care Unit) are considered to be an outside hospital.

Table 2 below displays the number of inmates incarcerated in the Massachusetts Department of Correction housed in a cell by correctional facility. The inmates who are not currently active in a cell are termed as OUT-OF-DOC Transfer and the table provides a separate count of these inmates.
