## Notice of Public Comment Period: 2015/2016 Annual Spiny Dogfish Trip Limit Specifications

For the 2015/2016 commercial spiny dogfish fishery, the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission's (ASMFC) Spiny Dogfish Board approved a 29.35 million pound quota and 5,000 pound trip limit for the Northern Region (ME-CT). To establish limits for the state's 2015/2016 commercial spiny dogfish fishery, the Director of the Division of Marine Fisheries is accepting comment on the following annual specifications:

- 1. Beginning May 1, 2015 it shall be unlawful for any commercial vessel or commercial permit holder to possess or land in excess of 5,000-lbs. of spiny dogfish per trip or per calendar day, whichever is longer; and
- 2. Once the Director has determined that the northern states' allocation (58%) of the ASMFC-approved quota has been reached, it shall be unlawful for commercial fishermen to land or possess any spiny dogfish.

The Director will declare annual specifications following this public comment period and upon approval by the Marine Fisheries Advisory Commission. The Director's Declaration will be published in a local newspaper, the Massachusetts Register, distributed through *MarineFisheries* Listserv and posted on the *MarineFisheries* website.
