The 2017 Vibrio (*Vp.*) season begins on May 21st and runs until October 16th. During this time the commercial harvest and handling of oysters must be conducted in accordance with the 2017 *Vp.* control plan and implementing regulations found at 322 CMR 16.05. You can find the 2017 Vibrio Control Plan and regulations at the Division's Shellfish Program *Vp.* Website, as well as links to Harvester and Dealer Training Videos and a link to online proactive tools for harvesters to further assist in *Vp.* risk reduction.

Vp. Logbooks can be picked up from your local Shellfish Department.

An additional link that maybe useful for aquaculturists, is the Division's <u>Approved Seed Source and Growers Site</u>. This site has an updated list of permitted growers and approved shellfish seed sources.
