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

## **Declaration to Fish Area 1A for Trimester 2**

The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission's Atlantic Herring Section has approved Addendum I to Amendment 3 of the Interstate Fishery Management Plan for Atlantic Herring. The Addendum includes the requirement of harvesters to declare their intent to fish in Management Area 1A during Trimester 2.

To opt-in, you must submit the <u>linked form</u> and return it to the Division of Marine Fisheries. The completed form must be returned via e-mail (catherine.o'keefe@state.ma.us), fax (617-626-1509) or by post to the attention of Cate O'Keefe, 251 Causeway Street, Suite 400, Boston, MA 02114.

For "Category A" federal permit holders, your declaration form must be received by DMF by no later than noon Monday, May 22, 2017. For those small mesh bottom trawl vessels with a "Category C" or "Category D" federal permit, your declaration form must be received by DMF by no later than May 31, 2017.

The meeting will begin at 10:30am and will be held at the NH Fish and Game Department Headquarters, 225 Main St., Durham, NH 03824.
