The Health Policy Commission will conduct a Listening Session on the internal and external review processes required by M.G.L. c. 176O and 958 CMR 3.00. The Office of Patient Protection (OPP), an office within the Health Policy Commission, regulates internal and external review procedures and administers the external review process for fully-insured health plans in Massachusetts.

The Listening Session will be part of the agenda for the meeting of the Health Policy Commission's Committee on Quality Improvement and Patient Protection (QIPP). The QIPP meeting begins at noon at the same location.

OPP is seeking general comments and input about the internal and external review processes, and whether there are ways to make the process more accessible to patients and consumers. Consumers, providers, advocates, health plans, and other stakeholders and members of the public are invited to provide oral or written comments on the following subjects:

- Internal review procedures
- External review procedures
- Suggestions for procedural changes, to make the process understandable and accessible to
 patients while complying with the requirements of the federal Affordable Care Act
- Issues or concerns related to internal and external review of behavioral health (mental health or substance use disorder) treatment coverage decisions
- Issues or concerns related to written external review decisions
