Lobster Trap Allocation Transfer Program Workshops: July 20<sup>th</sup> and July 21<sup>st</sup>

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) and the Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF) are co-hosting two workshops on the Lobster Trap Allocation Transfer Program in advance of the application period that begins on August 1<sup>st</sup>. The Lobster Trap Transfer Program gives permit holders in Lobster Conservation Management Areas 2, 3, and Outer Cape the flexibility to buy and sell trap allocation to help alleviate the impacts of trap cuts. This is the second year of the Lobster Trap Allocation Transfer Program. The details for the two meetings are as follows:
