Brief Description of Internship Position:

The EEA IT Cybersecurity intern will work directly with EEA's Director of Information Security and Compliance to identify security vulnerabilities, produce security policies, and advise and educate users on how to protect themselves.

Description of Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Devise communications materials to educate EEA users on new and emerging cyber threats.
2. Research cyber trends that might impact EEA and offer recommendations on new policies and processes to address them.
3. Ensure that appropriate access controls are in-place for EEA's information systems.
4. Reconcile information contained within EEA IT systems matches information within EEA HR systems and, ensuring only authorized users have access to EEA systems and services.
