



**Historic Parkways Initiative**  
**Memorial Drive Demonstration Project**  
**Phase II**  
**Contract No. P02-2162-C1A**



This project is the second phase of DCR's planned rehabilitation and restoration of Memorial Drive located between the BU Boathouse and the Longfellow Bridge. The project includes the construction of a multi-use bike path, riverbank stabilization, landscape improvements to the expanded parkland involving the installation of new shade shelters, benches, railings, trees, plantings and historical appropriate lighting. This project also includes the installation of new roadway drainage components to alleviate roadway flooding and improve stormwater quality.

## **TWO WEEK LOOK-AHEAD**

**October 31, 2016 – November 14, 2016**

The following activities will be occurring over the next two weeks.

### **Memorial Drive (Vassar Street– Longfellow Bridge)**

- Continue installing new trees, shrubs, plantings and lawn areas along the Charles River located between the BU Boathouse and the MIT Boathouse
- Continue reseeding and reestablishing lawn areas located in the medians
- Start installation of the ornamental fencing located adjacent to the BU Boathouse
- Start installation of the new ornamental shade shelters

**Construction Work Schedule/Hours:** Monday – Friday 6 AM to 4 PM

Pedestrians may use the existing sidewalks and pathways. Please follow the construction signing.

One travel lane in each direction will be maintained through the work area on Memorial Drive. On street parking will be prohibited in the work area.

**Access to properties will be limited at times during the work shift but restored at the end of the work shift**
