Adjustments to Trimester 3
Atlantic Sea Herring Fishery Management in Area 1A

The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission's (ASMFC) Sea Herring Section has adjusted the daysout measures for federal Category A permit holders during the Trimester 3 Atlantic Sea Herring Fishery in Management Area 1A. Federal Category A permit holders participating in this fishery will receive permit conditions from DMF establishing these new limits. These changes become effective at 0001 Friday, November 16, 2018.

 Participating vessels may fish for, possess and land sea herring taken from Management Area 1A seven
 (7) consecutive days per week, one landing per 24 hour period.

Federal Category A permits are issued to large scale sea herring harvesters, including mid-water trawl and purse seine vessels. Federal Category C and D permit holders (e.g., small mesh bottom trawlers), may continue to participate in the Trimester 3 Management Area 1A fishery and fish for passess, and land see herring seven 41°N
